THE MINOR

Minors, either disciplinary or interdisciplinary, may be closely related to a student's major, selected as an alternative field of specialization, or chosen simply for personal enrichment.

Generally, a minor is no more than six courses and ensures that a student pursues an area of study in some breadth and depth beyond the introductory level and outside of the major.

Students may declare only one disciplinary minor. While students may complete the requirements for more than one minor, only one minor will be noted on your final transcript. Students may complete both a disciplinary minor and an interdisciplinary minor.

Interdisciplinary Minors

Interdisciplinary minors give students the opportunity to explore, in some depth, a well defined question or topic beyond the major. Students interested in pursuing an Interdisciplinary minor should contact Prof. Peter Ubertaccio for details.

Because the minor must be outside of the major, the following major/minor combinations are not valid:

<u>Major</u>	<u>Invalid Minor</u>
Biochemistry majors (BC)	may not minor in Biology (BI) or Chemistry (CH)
Business majors (AC, FI, IB, MG, MK, UNB)	may not minor in Business (BS)
Education majors (ES, ESE, ESC)	may not minor in Secondary Education (SE)
Neuroscience majors (NS)	may not minor in Biology (BI) or Psychology (PC)
Visual & Performing Arts majors	may not minor in the same Vis. & Perf. area as the major
