Because Stonehill College is very concerned with the safety of our students, any propped residence hall exterior door found by the Residence Life staff, Campus Police or Facilities Management will be documented. A fine per occurrence will be assessed to all students in the building, unless an individual student is found responsible.

Each year the Director of Residence Life, or designee, will maintain and publish detailed information regarding door propping on the Residence Life website.

### *Procedures regarding Door Propping Policy*

Because Stonehill College is very concerned with the safety of our students, any propped residence hall exterior door found by the Residence Life staff, Campus Police or Facilities Management will be documented. A fine per occurrence will be assessed to all students in the building, unless an individual student is found responsible.

The fining system is outlined below:

- 1-5 times documented = \$.50 per student per documentation
- 6-10 times documented = \$1.00 per student per documentation
- 11+ time documented = \$2.00 per student per documentation

Courts houses that have been documented for a combined total of 25 propped doors will be administered a one-week adjustment. For “wet” houses, the adjustment revokes the alcohol and social gathering privileges outlined in the Substance Awareness Policy. For “dry” houses, the adjustment extends the duration of their “dry” status by one week. Following the first adjustment, every five documented propped doors will result in a minimum of one additional week adjustment. As houses are issued additional adjustments, the duration will increase.
