College furniture may not be removed from a student's room, nor may common area furniture be appropriated for a student's exclusive use and moved from lounges to his or her private room.

The College provides lounge furniture for interior use only and students should recognize that exterior use and movement tends to damage furniture. Therefore, houses, suites, or individuals may not move College furniture outside of the building for any purpose.

No personal couches or chairs will be allowed in Colonial Court, Commonwealth Court, the Pilgrim Heights common areas, or Notre Dame du Lac lounges or study rooms.

Students are limited to three cushions of personal furniture in their room.

Lofts are prohibited, unless provided by the College.

Students who violate the furniture policy will be fined an amount determined by the Director of Residence Life.

Procedures regarding Furniture Policy

College furniture may not be removed from a student's room, nor may common area furniture be appropriated for a student's exclusive use and moved from lounges to his or her private room.

The College provides lounge furniture for interior use only and students should recognize that exterior use and movement tends to damage furniture. Therefore, houses, suites, or individuals may not move College furniture outside of the building for any purpose.

No personal couches or chairs will be allowed in Colonial Court, Commonwealth Court, the Pilgrim Heights common areas, or Notre Dame du Lac lounges or study rooms.

Students are limited to three cushions of personal furniture in their room.

Lofts are prohibited, unless provided by the College.

Moving furniture from lounge areas to one's private room will result in a fine of \$25.00. The College reserves the right to fine houses, suites and individuals \$50-\$100 if furniture is moved outside.
