Stonehill College has certain expectations of student in regards to the living conditions of their residence area. They include, but are not limited to, the following:

- Residents are responsible for the cleanliness of their respective rooms, which are subject to inspection for health and safety reasons.
- Perishable foods may not be stored in student rooms unless kept refrigerated. Any other food items kept in rooms must be stored in closed containers to avoid attracting and harboring insects and to avoid contamination of food.
- Kitchens or kitchenettes are provided in many of the residence areas for preparing light individual snacks.
- Residents are responsible for seeing that kitchen areas are kept in a clean and orderly condition. Failure to maintain appropriate sanitary standards constitutes justification for closing the kitchen area or billing students for damage/clean-up.
