The cooperation of every student is expected for the maintenance of an atmosphere conducive to study. Relative quiet is expected at all times; however, the Residence Life Office designates certain hours as quiet hours. These quiet hours are considered important for study and sleep in the residence halls, and it is the responsibility of individual students to observe these rules in a spirit of civility; therefore, they are to be enforced by all members of the community.

Additional quiet hours are enforced during exam periods.

Each year the Director of Residence Life, or designee, will maintain and publish the designated quiet hours on the Residence Life website.

Procedures regarding Quiet Hours Policy

The cooperation of every student is expected for the maintenance of an atmosphere conducive to study. Relative quiet is expected at all times; however, the Residence Life Office designates certain hours as quiet hours. These quiet hours are considered important for study and sleep in the residence halls, and it is the responsibility of individual students to observe these rules in a spirit of civility; therefore, they are to be enforced by all members of the community.

Quiet hours are:

Sunday through Thursday: 10:00pm – 8:00am

Friday through Saturday: 1:00am – 9:00am

During exam periods, 24-hour quiet hours are enforced.
